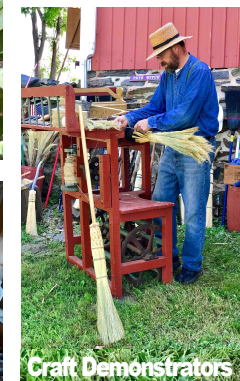
Sunday House Tours
